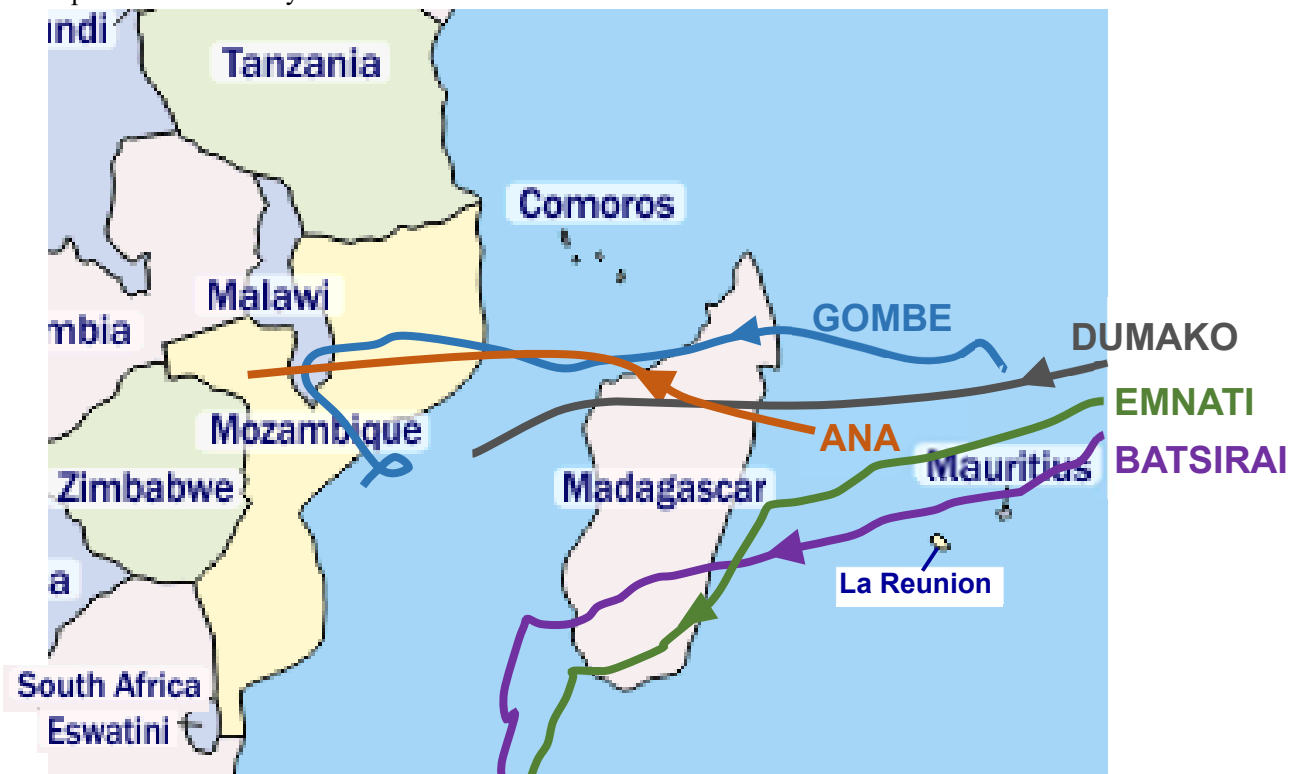


## Madagascar, Mozambique, Malawi Cyclones and Tropical Storms

Outline	Madagascar was struck by five tropical storms/cyclones in just one month and a half, and the floods affected northern coast, eastern coast, and the central plateau. For the eastern coast, successive storms gave no time to recover, which accelerate the damages. Mozambique was also damaged by three tropical storms/cyclones, and Malawi was affected by two.		

The figures of victims are based on U.N. OCHA reports of February 2, 13, 14, 22, March 2, April 13, 2022, Madagascar Government report of March 2, 2022, International Federation of Red Cross report of April 8 and media information of February 3 and March 15, 2022.
