

Outline	In western Africa, rainy season rainfall exceeded the average by more than 400 mm, causing widespread flood damage in the middle and lower reaches of the Niger River, its tributary the Benue River, and rivers flowing into Lake Chad. In Maiduguri city, Nigeria, located along the Ngadda river of the Lake Chad basin, the collapse of an upstream reservoir caused severe flood, with 40% of the city inundated.	Missing*	-
