

## Typhoon GAEMI

Period Outline	The powerful typhoon GAEMI, with a strong wind radius of 500 km, passed off the eastern coast of the Philippines, but Luzon was caught in the storm zone, bringing more than 500 mm of heavy rain and river flooding. It then made landfall and crossed Taiwan with the force of a super typhoon. It still had a strong wind radius of 600 km when it made landfall in Fujian Province, China. Although it weakened to a tropical depression, heavy rain of more than 600 mm was brought to the inland province of Hunan and the northern province of Liaoning, and multiple rivers, including those on the border with North Korea, overflowed, causing widespread flooding and landslides.
